#### **DISCUSSION:**

On June 4, 2015, the Commission Board approved Resolution Nos. 2015-001 & 2015-002, Adopting the Proposed Fiscal Year 2015-16 General Fund and PEG Fee Fund Budgets for the Sacramento Metropolitan Cable Television Commission, along with the direction to add \$600,000 to the franchise fee revenue projections, which would enhance the revenue distributions for member agencies. In addition, the Board approved a 7% COLA for Channel Licensees' Operations/Equipment Bases instead of the 4% COLA recommended by staff.

#### General Fund (094A) Budget

The actual revenues and expenditures realized in the General Fund Budget for Fiscal Year 2014-15 resulted in an increase to the Fiscal Year 2015-16 beginning fund balance. The carry forward fund balance from the previous year includes \$269,822 to recognize an account receivable related to the Calendar Years 2011 & 2012 Audit of Comcast. While it is appropriated to show this receivable as revenue, staff is recommending an increase in the addition to the reserve for this amount. While the Comcast security deposit has been used to partially offset this account receivable, it is prudent to add the amount of the security deposit (\$223,976) plus the remaining account receivable (\$45,846) to the General Fund Reserve.

The Final General Fund (094A) Budget as presented for Fiscal Year 2015-16 includes adjustments to line items to include:

- Increase of \$600,000 for Member Agency Revenue Distribution (from \$10,717,243 to \$11,317,243)
- Increase of 3% to the COLA for Channel Licensees' Operations Base (from 4% to 7%)
- Increase of \$20,000 for Temp Help (from \$30,000 to \$50,000)
- Increase of \$25,000 for Professional Services (from \$125,000 to \$150,000)
- Increase of \$15,000 for Closed Captioning (from \$110,000 to \$125,000)
- Increase of \$2,000 for Sac County Wide Cost Allocation-A87 (from \$3,000 to \$5,000)
- Increase of \$50,000 for Fund Balance Reserved (from \$100,000 to \$150,000)
- Addition of a line item of \$269,822 for Fund Balance Reserved (Comcast Security Deposit of \$223,976 + remaining receivable of \$45,846 from Comcast CYs 2011 & 2012 Audit finding of \$269,822)
- Increase of \$12,874 for Contingency Appropriation (from \$20,000 to \$32,874)

#### PEG Fee Fund (094B) Budget

The actual revenues and expenditures figures realized in the PEG Fee Fund Budget for Fiscal Year 2014-15 also resulted in an increase to the Fiscal Year 2015-16 beginning fund balance. Similar to the General Fund, the carry forward fund balance from the previous year includes \$38,576 to recognize an account receivable related to Comcast's FYs 2011 & 2102 Audit. The carry forward balance is also higher due to PEG projects that either costs less or were not entirely completed as expected.

The Final PEG Fee Fund (094B) Budget as presented for Fiscal Year 2015-16 includes the following adjustments:

- Increase of 3% to the COLA for Channel Licensees' Equipment Base (from 4% to 7%)
- Increase of \$89,578 for the Sac County PEG project (to cover outstanding costs for the FY 2014-15 PEG project that were expected to be uncured in the previous year)
- Increase of \$3,500 for AT&T VRAD Equipment (from \$1,500 to \$5,000)
- Decrease of \$13,332 for Contingency Appropriation (from \$74,979 to \$61,647)
- Addition of a line item of \$38,576 for Contingency Appropriation (A/R from Comcast's CYs 2011 & 2012 Audit finding)

It is recommended the Board approve Resolutions No. 2015-009 and 2015-010, adopting the Fiscal Year 2015-16 Final General Fund (094A) and PEG Fee Fund (094B) Budgets, along with the attached documents.

#### PRIOR FINDINGS FOR THE TWO YEARS ENDED DECEMBER 31, 2010

#### **PEG Fees Collected**

In May of 2009, the Commission began collecting a one percent (1%) PEG fees on gross revenue as allowed by the Digital Infrastructure and Video Act of 2006. Surewest has the option to pass through these fees to their customers. If they pass these PEG fees through to their customers, these fees collected are includable as gross revenue for both the franchise fees due and the PEG fees due. Surewest did not include these fees collected as part of gross revenue for both the franchise fee and PEG calculations. In addition, the PEG Fees collected did not originally include amounts related home shopping revenues and Franchise fees passed through to customers, which were findings from the previous audit for franchise fees.

#### Recommendation

We recommend that Surewest include the PEG fees charged to their customers in the calculation of gross revenue reported for both the franchise fees due and the PEG fees due. In addition, we recommend that the gross revenues reported for PEG fees due include amounts for Franchise Fees passed through to customers and home shopping revenues.

#### **Current Status**

Surewest now includes all income, as noted above, in the calculation of gross revenues.
